

Proposed Amendments to Admissions Policy

ALLOCATION OF PLACES

5.1 Admission Number

In 2021 and 2022 there will be 3 admission points for years 7,9 and 10 and a further admission point for year 12. From 2023 there will be three admission points in years 7 and 10 with a further admission point for year 12.

Published Admission Numbers

The number of places in each year group will be as follows in each of those three years of admission.

5.2 Oversubscription Criteria for Year 7,9,10,12

5.2.1 If there are more applicants than places, the following process will apply. After the admission of students with EHCPs in which GPUTC is named, as outlined below, criteria will be applied to those students who have a demonstrable interest in our specialisms for the remaining places in the order in which they are set out below:

- 1) Any Looked After Children in the care of a local authority, and previously looked after children, regardless of where they are resident.
- 2) Children who have a sibling currently on roll at GPUTC.
- 3) Children of staff.
- 4) Places for all other applications will be allocated on the basis of distance measured in a straight line from the child's home to the UTC.

5.3 Waiting Lists

5.3.1 Where, in any year, GPUTC receives more eligible applications than there are places available, a waiting list will be maintained by GPUTC until the end of the first term of the school year. If and when places become available, they will be allocated to those on the waiting list in line with the Oversubscription Criteria set out above.
